Good Friday Tenebrae Service March 29, 2024



Tenebrae (Latin: "shadows") Vespers offers the faithful a spiritual commemoration of our Lord's sufferings into death, during His 3 hours on the cross. Progressively extinguished candles would be visual reminders of Jesus' ebbing life as the Light of the world.

Yet the Pascal Candle symbolizes the promise of Christ's sacrifice is the one persevering shining light of God the Father's steadfast grace and mercy. The Savior forgivingly abides with us, even in the midst of universal humanity's darkness of sinful rebellion and evil rejection of God with us.

Invocation

P: In the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

P: Behold the life-giving cross of the Son of God, the Savior of the world.

C: O come let us worship Him.

P: Heavenly Father, graciously behold Your erring children.

C: O Lord, deliver Your people and save us by Your grace in Christ Jesus, that we may live by faith in Your forgiveness.

P: We are all like sheep that have gone astray.

- C: The Good Shepherd lays down His life for His flock. May His loving voice guide us through this world and lead us to life everlasting.
- P: The evening gloom is a nightly reminder of the darkness our sinful rebellion casts over creation, and the evil corruption which overshadows our hearts.
- C: Jesus is the light of the world. The Lamb of God bids our penitent spirits to find rest at the foot of His cross.
- P: The death of Christ comforts our souls with God's divine covenant to never forsake us.
- C: By faith in His sufferings we cast off our selfish addiction for temporal comforts, and put off our coveting for temporary securities.
- P: May the light the Paschal Candle illuminate the eyes of our hearts with faith and hope in the promise of Jesus' cross.
- C: Holy Spirit, help us walk in the light of the crucified Savior, so the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin. Triune God let it be done, now and forever. Amen.

READING - Tortured and Condemned

P: God sends His Word and heals His own; He rescues His people from the grave.

- P: Christ, Your death on the cross made a public spectacle of humanity's evil instincts for self-justification; for wicked urges of economic self-preservation; and corrupt cravings for political survival of the fittest. We confess our sinful inclinations to practice such plots, schemes and intrigues. We repent of the hurt our hypocrisy causes You, and the harm such abuses cause others.
- C: By faith in Your holy cross, grant us the discipline to overcome our scorn for the weak, and our superficial condescension towards the helpless. Make us bold to believe in the ways of Your sacrificial love toward us, so by our faith and hope in You bear fruits of justice, and yields a harvest of sacrificial love towards others. O Lord, have mercy on us.
